

LICENSE INFORMATION DOCUMENT

Program Name:

HCL Domino Complete Collaboration 14.5 (Perpetual License)

The Program is provided in two models with separate entitlement requirements:

- HCL Domino Complete Collaboration Business Edition 14.5 (“**CCB**” or the “**Program**”)
- HCL Domino Complete Collaboration External Users 14.5
a Program add-on available as a Term License (“**CCX**”)

The following terms apply to the use of the Program:

Definitions:

Licensee. For the purposes of this License Information Document, Licensee shall also mean Customer, an End User or other holder of an entitlement to which the License Information Document relates.

Limited use right

As described in the HCL Master License Agreement available at: <https://www.hcl-software.com/resources/master-agreements> or the applicable agreement between HCL and Licensee (“**MLA**”) and this License Information Document, HCL grants Licensee a limited right to use the Program. This right is limited to the level of Authorized Use defined in License Metric below or other specified level of use, paid for by Licensee and evidenced by the proof of entitlement. Licensee's use may also be subject to other restrictions as prescribed in this License Information Document.

Supporting Programs

Supporting programs are additional software provided to Licensee to support the operation and functionality of the Program (“**Supporting Programs**”). Licensee is authorized to install and use the Supporting Programs listed below in accordance with the license grant in the Master License Agreement, the relevant Order or such other relevant agreement for the Program only. The Supporting Programs may not be used for any other purpose.

A Supporting Program may be subject to the terms of a separate License Information Document (published here: [HCL License Agreements \(hcl-software.com\)](https://www.hcl-software.com/resources/master-agreements)) or and those terms, if any, shall also apply to the use of that Supporting Program. In the event of conflict, the terms in this License Information document supersede the terms of the Supporting Program. Sufficient entitlements to the Program must be obtained, as a whole, to cover installation and use of all of the Supporting Programs unless separate entitlements are provided within this License Information document. When Licensee's right to use the Program expires or terminates, Licensee must discontinue use, destroy or promptly return all copies of the Supporting Programs to HCL or the party from whom the Program was acquired. - The following Supporting Programs of HCL Domino Leap cannot be used:
 - HCL Lotus Enterprise Integrator for Domino
 - HCL Domino Connector for SAP Solutions
 - HCL Link

Software Development Kit

Multi-Product Install

The Program is provided as part of a multi-product install image. Licensee is authorized to install and use only the Program (and its bundled or Supporting Programs, if any) for which a valid entitlement is obtained and may not install or use any of the other software included in the image unless Licensee has acquired separate entitlements for that other software.

Any server established under the Program can only be accessed by an Authorized User as well as an HCL Domino Messaging Express Authorized User or as otherwise defined herein.

Authorized use includes that HCLSoftware Domino servers may participate in mail routing (SMTP), directory lookup and authentication (LDAP) for any Program, permit access to free/busy time information, and may replicate with any HCLSoftware Domino server anywhere.

At HCLSoftware's request, Licensee must present a Domino License Analysis Utility ("DLAU") report to substantiate needed licensed capacity prior to HCLSoftware's acceptance of an Order for entitlements or Support renewal. DLAU is described here: <https://opensource.hcltechsw.com/domino-license-analysis-utility-DLAU>.

Metric

The following units of measure may apply to Licensee's use of the Program:

“Authorized User”

An Authorized User is a unique person or designated identity having credentials for authenticated access to the Program. The unique person or designated identity is defined by the Domino Directory and any other authentication source used by Licensee (“Authorized User” and “A/U”). Any employee, temporary agency staff, contractor, consultant or service provider requiring access to the Program must be an A/U. In addition, Licensee can assign credentials to a non-employee, a specific job title or role, a specific task or an individual process as an A/U, provided that each non-employee, job role, task or process is separately authenticated as required above. For the avoidance of doubt, if Licensee assigns an A/U to a non-employee, specific job role, task or process, all unique users or designated identities using that ID must also be designated as an A/U. An A/U entitlement is unique to the A/U and may not be shared and may not be reassigned other than for the permanent transfer of the entitlement to another A/U. Licensee must obtain separate, dedicated A/U entitlements for each credential permitting authenticated access. The DLAU tool counts the needed licensed capacity for Licensee's Program and CCX configuration. In addition to the A/Us, the Program entitlement includes limited access to Domino servers for the below users.

“Guest User”

A guest user can be granted anonymous access, where access to the Program is provided without verification of a user's unique identity (“Guest User”).

“Known Guest”

A known guest user is a non-employee provided with authenticated access with a restricted maximum level of Domino application access (ACL) as reader and permission to write public documents (“Known Guest”).

“CCX User”

In addition, Licensee can obtain separate, dedicated CCX user entitlements for each non-employee provided with authenticated access with a restricted maximum level of Domino application access (ACL) as an editor. CCX users can not be provided access to a personal mailbox. A CCX entitlement is unique, but may be reassigned to another same class user after 30 (thirty) days of inactivity. Dedicated CCX User licenses are provided on a term basis and must be renewed accordingly (“CCX User”).

None of Licensee's employees are permitted as Known Guest or CCX User. The DLAU tool will include the above users in the needed licensed capacity report.

The Program may be installed on any number of computers or servers and each A/U may have simultaneous access to any number of instances of the Program at one time. If Licensee subscribes to Support for the Program above or other Programs which include one or more of the same Supporting Programs or component parts above, Licensee must subscribe to Support for the full volume of all entitlements for said Programs.
